Travel: We are 2 minutes walk from the Redhill bus and train stations. If you are parking you can use the Belfry Car Park which is open until midnight. Free parking is available after 6pm every day. Simply validate your ticket at The Light.

As well as being a cinema, The Light Redhill offers lots of different leisure activities such as climbing, mini golf, bowling, karaoke, shuffleboard and much more..

You can also just drop in to have a look around, and maybe have a drink, without doing any activities.

You are free to come in and out of the venue if you need a short break outside. After 9pm, The Light is an adult only venue and we may check your ID.

Food and drink

You can buy drinks, meals and snacks in our bar areas both upstairs and downstairs.

The main bar area can be busy downstairs and there's usually music playing. There are quieter areas in the venue to sit away from the bar.



The upstairs area tends to be quieter and there are tables chairs and sofas upstairs.



Busy times and quieter times

Our busiest times tend to be Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays (though Sunday evening is often less busy).

We have a DJ on a Saturday night from 8pm.

There will often be children's parties at the weekend during the day, which can be noisy!

Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays tend to be our quieter days and evenings.



We do have ear defenders you can borrow free of charge from the 'Game On' counter.

Disabled Access

The venue is accessible for wheelchair users, although mini golf may be tricky for a wheelchair user to make their way around.

Assistance dogs are welcome.



Toilets

As well as disabled toilet facilities, we have a Changing Places toilet with a hoist and changing table.



Lift

The lift will take you upstairs where the cinema screens, mini golf and climbing wall.

The lift is in the arcade area.

We are part of the CEA card scheme

Having this card allows free entry for a carer or companion accompanying disabled guests to the cinema. You can book your CEA ticket online or at the venue.

Choose the screening you wish to attend, select 'Add a CEA carer ticket' and enter your unique CEA card number. Select 'Add to Order' and complete your booking.

Our cinema screens

We have 6 screens and each screen has wheelchair access.

We offer relaxed screenings for neurodivergent audiences and those with sensory sensitivities. The sound is turned down and the lights are dimmed, not turned off. Guests are welcome to move seats if they want and can bring in their own food. Our relaxed screenings are ideal for some autistic people, youngsters and adults with learning disabilities.

Some autistic people may prefer to choose to come to watch a film at quieter times rather than a relaxed screening.

Mini Golf

Our course is a lot of fun, but it might be challenging for younger players so we recommend players are 6+ years olds.

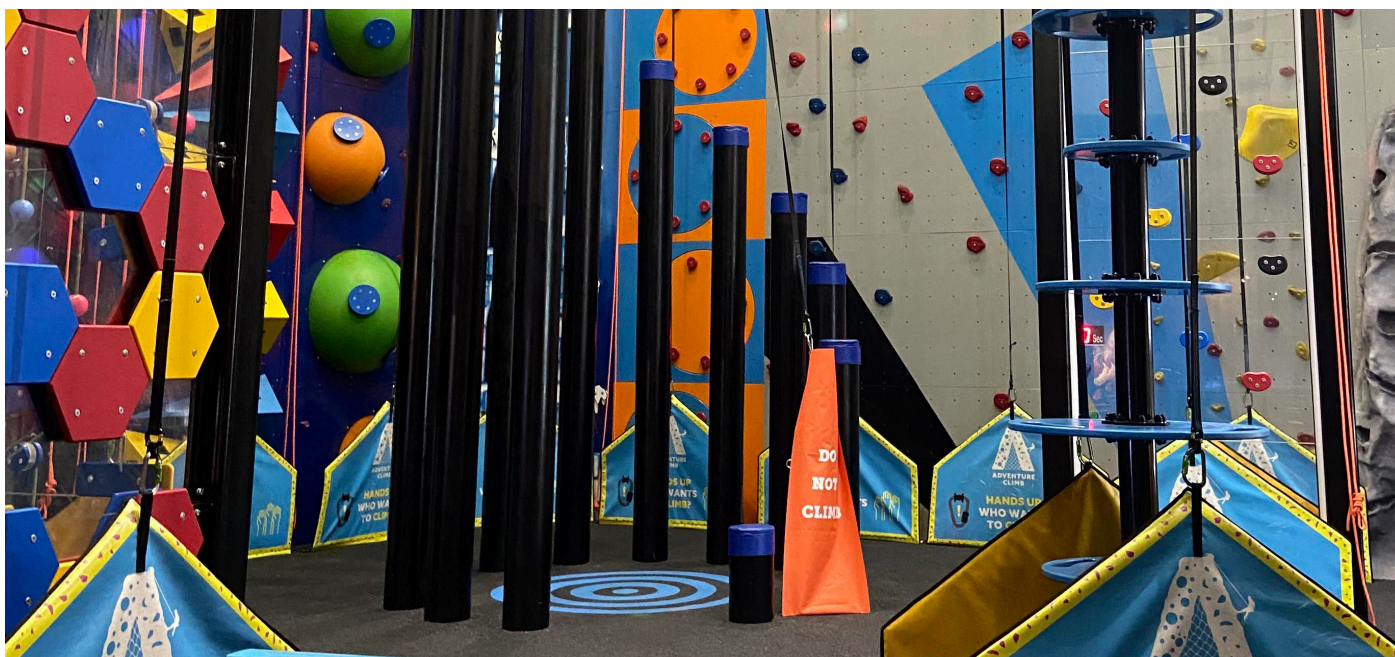

Adventure Climb

You'll start your climbing session with a 20 minute safety briefing and harness fitting, followed by a 55 minute climbing session.

Bowling

The pins we use are lighter and more rounded in shape, and the lanes are not as long as traditional ten pin bowling.

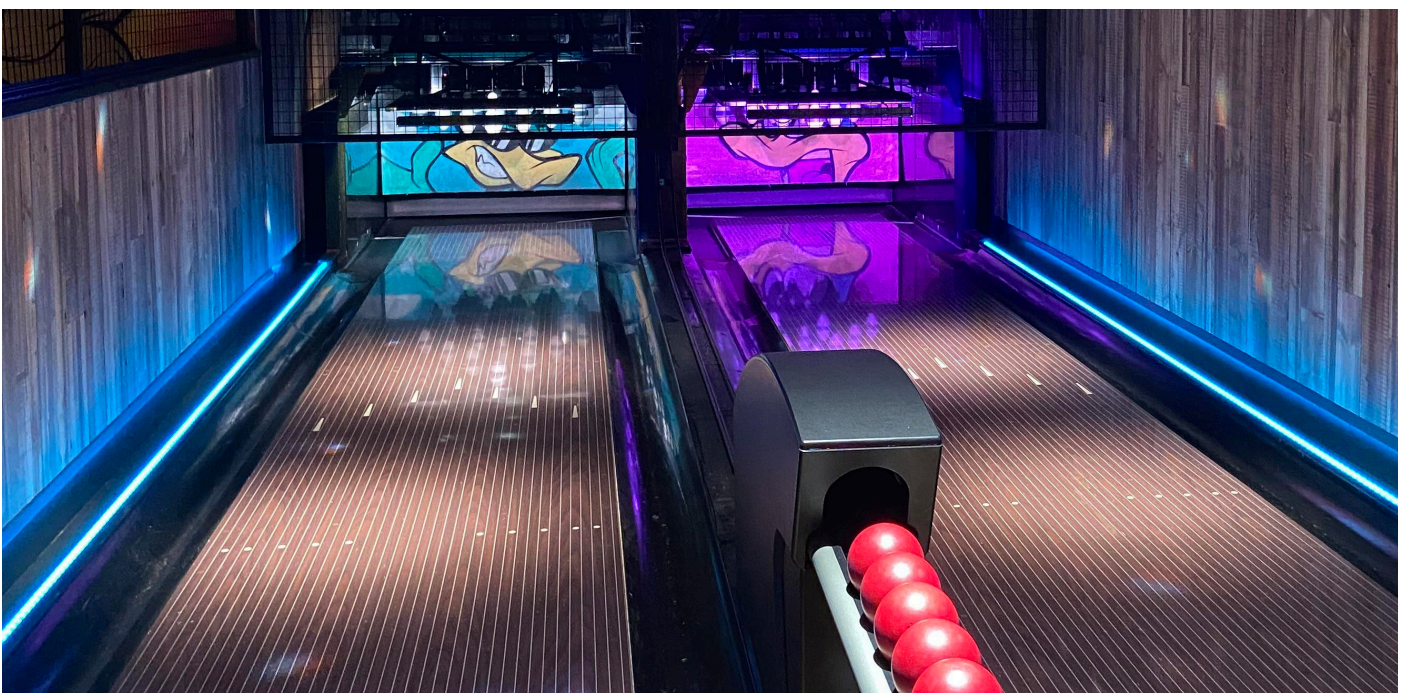
Bowling is quite noisy and can get busy during peak times.

Experience darts like never before with our fully interactive system with a range of fun games from traditional bullseye to Halve It and Disco Wall.

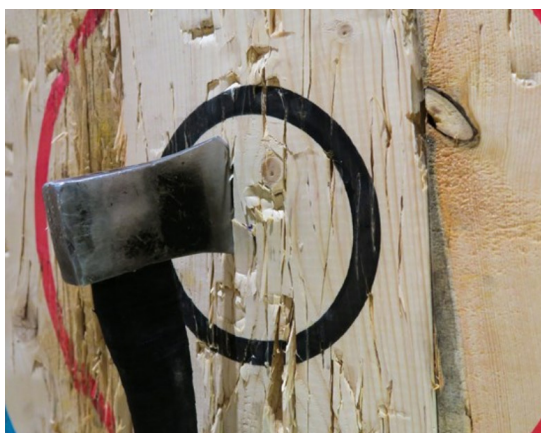

The aim of the game is to slide the curling stones at the centre of the target. The player with the most stones nearest the centre wins!

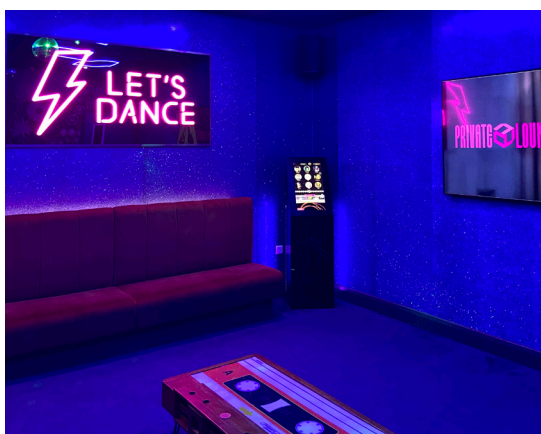

Our range of fun and competitive digital games allows you to compete against friends and family.

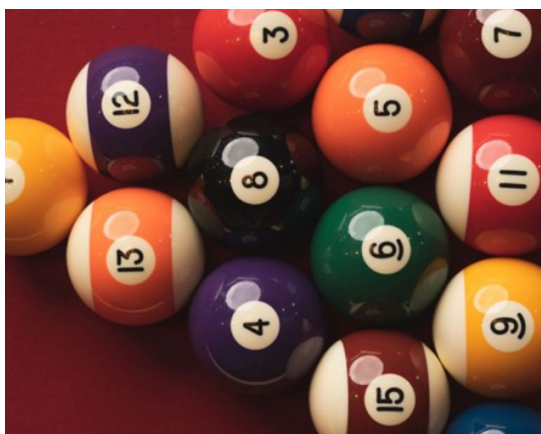
This is in a quieter area of the venue.
